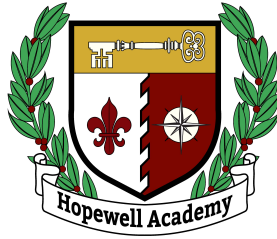

Welcome | Overview

Welcome to the Hopewell Academy admissions application. All students interested in attending Hopewell for grades 6 through 12 are required to fill out this application. In the following pages, the applicant will be asked to answer some basic informational questions. Additionally, the applicant will be asked to fill out two essays that will give our staff a better sense of the person she or he is. Following the applicant section, there is a parent/guardian information section. Also included in the application packet are recommendation forms (we require Math, English and Counselor/Administrator recommendations).

Instructions | Admissions Requirements

This application is one of six easy steps for the Hopewell Admissions process.

Additionally Required:

1. An **interview** with one of our admissions staff members.
2. The applicant's **grades and/or transcripts**. Including but not limited to cumulative school records, IEP and related testing reports and behavior/discipline records
3. **Standardized test scores**. For **high school applicants** we prefer PSAT, SAT, ACT, SSAT or TOEFL (for international students). For middle school applicants we prefer EOG, ERB or Iowa tests.
4. A **visit to campus**, if your family is local.
5. **Pay a \$30 application fee**, accepted when the application is submitted*
*you may request a fee waiver for financial reasons by emailing admissions@hopewellacademy.org

Other Information

The Admissions Committee will review each completed application and return a decision within two weeks. Hopewell Academy is a rolling admissions process.
